Gallery Pages on PSNM Website

Time to Renew or Apply!

The cost of having a web page is \$75 per year, payable annually at the time you renew your PSNM membership. This fee covers the setup of a new page, including a brief resume, artist's statement, and one to four correctly formatted digital images of your work. It must also include an email address or other contact information.

The gallery is updated three times a year, February, June, and October, when you provide new images in January, May and September. There is no additional cost for this service. If you wish to update text during the year, there will be an additional charge of \$10 to scan your typewritten text (handwritten text will not scan), but no charge for text submitted digitally via email. A reminder that it's time to update your images will be emailed to you at the appropriate time.
